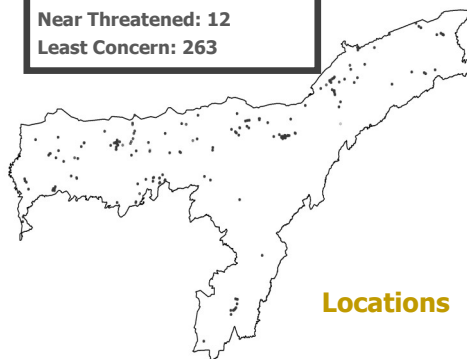

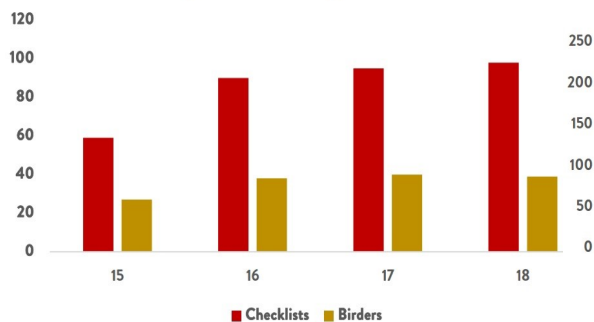

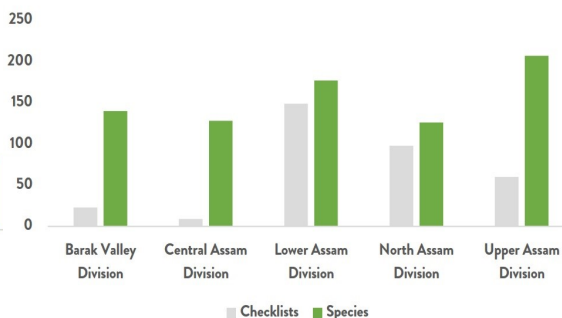

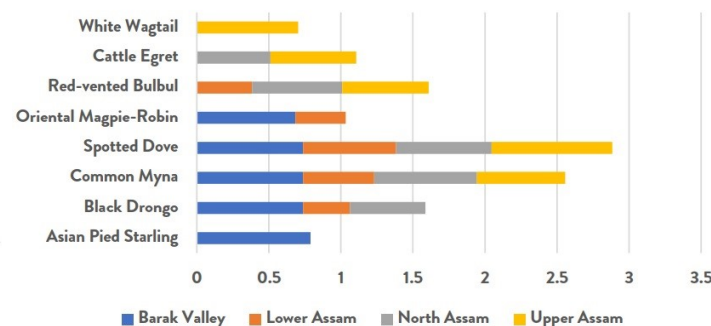
Daywise data during Bird Count
