Memo:

The Wildlife Wing of HP Forest Department invites bird-watchers of the department and across the state to take participate in the upcoming "Great Backyard Bird Count" to be held from 16 to 19 Feb 2024. As this is a citizen centric initiative, it allows public to document bird data and further contribute to bird conservation. This also presents a great opportunity to reach out to people and spread conservation awareness about birds.

Himachal Pradesh has a consistent presence in the bird counts' participation. Birding locations will include wildlife sanctuaries, national parks, conservation reserves, villages and urban areas. Since 2017, the Wildlife Wing has inspired its staff and birders in the state to take part in the event. The annual snapshots of bird populations collected during these events help to answer a variety of important bird conservation questions, including how birds are distributed across the state, how they are affected by changes in habitat and weather, and whether the bird populations and distributions are changing yearly or not.

Broad instructions for taking part in GBBC are:

- 1. Go birding for at least **15 minutes**, listing and counting all the species you see and can identify.
- 2. Submit your observations on "e-Bird".
- 3. **One or more** lists can be uploaded every day.

- 4. Leave out the birds which you cannot identify. One could also take photographs of not identifiable birds for respective identification at a later stage.
- 5. Repeat as often as convenient through the day, being sure to make a separate list for each location of you visit. If possible, continue birding even after dusk as many crepuscular and nocturnal birds like owls and nightjars become active and vocal at nights.
- 6. In case you cannot access a computer or mobile, a photograph of the birding (listing species and counts) can be emailed to anil.thakur.ifs@gmail.com& santoshwlg@gmail.com or even sent on Whatsapp numbers 94184-57800 and 94185-38303.
